### **Materials**

Groundsheet/tarp for each household group

Paper (A4)  
Pens/pencils - from home

### **Session Plan Overview**

Arrival and sit on separate ground sheets in household groups

News time - a quick newsround around the circle to share news from everyone's week/since the last time you met.

Paper plane activity - instructions below

Active game such as [Buzzy Bees](#) or similar

Link Your Hands Together - only hold hands in household groups

### **Instructions**

This is an activity to be done in pairs (from household/bubble groups) and involves listening and working together.

Each person has to hold one hand behind their back and in pairs work together to make a paper plane. Before you start folding your plane you can decorate the paper and maybe write who is on your plane, where they are going and what they will do when they get there. Set a time limit for making the planes, probably 20 mins max. Once the time is up and all the groups have a plane it's time to fly them! The group leader can mark a spot for each pair to come up to and throw their plane, and they can mark where each one lands (maybe dots of flour for this?)
